Parking Lot Replacement Project as of Sep 24th



On Monday, September 16th, the Project Management Team (PMT) met with a representative from Star Paving, and after some discussion they signed their Contract Proposal.

The official start date is Monday, Oct 14th. There is a certain amount of prep work that has to be completed before the paving can actually begin. In fact, they are starting on concrete work tomorrow (Wednesday) — curbs and gutters.

Per our agreement with Share Your Care (SYC), the church will be open during normal business hours. But parking will be limited with preference given to SYC's clients. Park in the street, if possible, since there will be trucks and other large machines moving about.

The work will proceed in an organized fashion, combining sidewalk concrete work, curbing, and the asphalt-laying processes. They will be starting from the east end of the parking lot and working their way to the west entrance, then finally going north to the dumpster.

There will be new 2-inch asphalt laid all around, as well as new sidewalks and curbing. And three new ADA-compliant concrete wheelchair ramps.

While this project is active, the PMT will provide weekly updates.
